Agenda topic Depot Update | Presenter Darko Hreljanovic, CDI President

- Depot to be seen as a resource- hiking, biking, river- looking to support and make awareness of the rich culture of the area- wants the depot to be seen as a resource
- Make a plan- to make front of depot as a public space with tables, etc-place bluestone, ect indigenous to the area. Turn a section into a public pedestrian space. Want to create a place to sit and enjoy the town and sit with friends
- Have a DASNY grant that will be a visitors center on the by way to bring it to Callicoon center point of the by way- about midpoint on the 72 mile- Callicoon is highly visible and accessible
- Will be interior and exterior spaces, workshops, etc.
- Asked about parking: It is a private property-there will be accessibility for public vehicles
- Have a lot of volunteers-not intended to be a public parking area

- The renovation: walk through a week ago significant replacement of roof, some water penetration, etc. a lot of money spent there- need bathrooms accessible and accessible for handicap. need to keep the structure that it is historic
- Lily asked: what's being done with the renovations
 - Cost estimate is on the way will get it in week or 2- will see how the DASNYgrant is and how
 we can use it- replacement of roof, water penetration some of the major issues
 - o Need ADA area, bathrooms accessible, etc- must be done in mind that it is a historic structure
 - Will get a report in a week or 2 and see what is said and compare it to the grant- will look at what we need to do with the money we have
- Once we have the estimate we deliver to DASNY and get to them to then hopefully begin with the construction
- The whole area will be closed up with the construction-the debris, the liability- the site will be closed during the construction- we are undergoing a transition and phasing public parking out slowly
- A transition phasing public parking out- cars will be eventually excluding
- A lot of damage has been happening-holes in stage, electricity ruined, etc.
- Roy: Darko- please talk about the Town hall meeting- people need to be aware of what is going
 on quarterly meeting first one at the end of June- can speak
- Parking has been an issue with the last few year not specifically a depot issue- it is a town issue
- Darko free wifi- posted on the bulletin board
- Riley suggested a system to extend the depot wifi through the hamlet. Will follow up to explore.
