- <u>Cost estimate</u> | We are going to reconcile the numbers so we can satisfy the preliminary needs. Trying to close the gap and then look at what we can do and so forth. Need to look at the estimate and what can be done
- <u>Outreach</u> | Have an open house last Sat of every month to engage and show the community about the depot
 - o Will have the Arts and Crafts this Saturday we are hosting- for this month
 - Within the depot a small scale book scale
 - Lee- flyers for the window to tell people about it
 - A tent that will have information about the CDI and the Depot
 - In the depot a small scale book sale- encourage people to come into the depot and see the historic importance.
- Depot Town hall | Schedules for Tuesday July 16th, 6-8 PM at the Delaware Youth Center
 - Will be more formal than the open house
- Parking I We now have several issues with property damage at the site.
 - o power lines have been ripped down 2 times, the stage has been backed into 2 times, breaking the railing and access door and damaging the new srage + many small run-ins with planters knocked over etc
 - This area is not a municipal parking lot + parking will be limited- etc
 - Lee: The Town doesn't lease the parking lot?
 - No The Town leases the opposite side that is paved only.
 - Rosie's area- the parking is public parking- is leased as public parking- the town pays insurance (Nicole)
 - The CBA/CDI has not strictly enforced parking as to not to make parking more difficult however as we are liable for insuring the space we can not say it is open to the public, nor take on liability for the public parking. We just don't have the resources to take on the expenses to upgrade to DOT standards or insure it properly for this use.
 - Once the Visitors Center is open there will be visitor center designated parking a
 pedestrian area will have tables and chairs- and a through driveway for emergency vehicles.
 - Darko- it's a very gray area- we have had damage on the property- we do not want to do it in a hostile way - but eventually it will not be accessible to public parking

- <u>Trash</u> | Lee- no place to put trash- people come into the shop and ask me, "can you take our trash?" where to put trash- I know you've brought up the issue.
 - We have 3 sets of cans that have seasonal pick up provided by the town. 1)railroad square 2) at the depot next to the billboard, and 3) in the alley next to 1906 only one pick up a week

- during high season will not increase it. can discuss taking a collection from merchants for more possibly?
- o Victoria: need signs- "please do not leave your trash"- people put them in the planters-
- Lee: we need to do something about this.
- <u>UPS Box</u> Lee: the new owners did not want it there- need to find a business that will have the UPS box next to them
- <u>Sullivan County Budget Allocation</u> | Nicole: We received an approval for \$2000 to put up way-finding signage on 17B + signs for North Branch Cider Mill, North Branch Inn, Gardner & Co. General Store & Buckbrook Alpacas.
 - As Callicoon retail locations fill and the CBA expands into the larger area, it's important to work to expand to additional retail corridors to support our businesses.
